## RULES

Scores will be automatically tabulated at each trial event.

A dog is only eligible for one award category

Scores will be taken from all runs, qualifying or not. The exception is if the Handler or Judge calls time and the dog receives a "JCT" or HCT", then a zero will be entered for that run. You do not have to be entered in all trials & all stock to participate, but obviously it is to your advantage to do so. Scores will be taken from up to 10 runs per stock. If a dog receives more than 10 scores for one or more type of stock, the top & bottom scores will be dropped for each type of stock to equal 10 runs. If the dog has 11 scores, it's top score will be dropped.

All WTCH dogs will be tabulated equally.

All Open dogs have the option of moving up to Advanced anytime during the Series and will remain in the Non-WTCH category regardless of whether they earn their WTCH during any of the 3 weekends. The dog must <u>not</u> have earned a WTCH prior to entering the first trial they are entered in.

All Started dogs will be tabulated equally, as long as they stay in the Started class. Once they move up to Open, they have the option of moving into the Open/Non-WTCH category and bring their Started scores with them <u>OR</u> they can remain in the Started category & only their started scores will be counted.

For dogs that begin the series entered in both Started & Open classes for different stock, you will be tabulated in the Open/Non-WTCH category <u>UNLESS</u> you wish to only use your started scores for the Started Category. Make a note on the entry form of the first trial that you enter stating which category you are vying for, even if you are only entering one weekend.

In the case of a tie, the dog with the highest combined Cattle scores will win. In the case of a second tie, the dog with the single highest Cattle score will win.
